Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable William E. Davis, Judge of the Lake Superior Court, Civil Division 5, has notified the Court that he will be retiring from that court effective at the close of business on April 30, 2019. We find that in the interest of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of judge of the Lake Superior Court, Civil Division 5. Senior Judge Diane Kavadias Schneider has indicated her willingness to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Lake Superior Court, Civil Division 5.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Diane Kavadias Schneider is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Lake Superior Court, Civil Division 5, effective May 1, 2019. Judge Schneider's appointment shall remain effective until further order of this Court or a successor assumes the office, whichever occurs first.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Schneider to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Lake Superior Court, Civil Division 5. Judge Schneider shall be entitled to compensation for this service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of her appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
