Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Court has been made aware that the Honorable Brad Jacobs, Judge of the Clark Circuit Court 2, will be temporarily unable to perform the duty of his office effective immediately. We find that in the interest of continuing the orderly administration of justice and pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63(B)(1), a Judge *Pro Tempore* should be appointed temporarily to discharge the duties of judge of the Clark Circuit Court 2. Senior Judge Kenneth L. Lopp has indicated his willingness to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Clark Circuit Court 2.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Senior Judge Lopp is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Clark Circuit Court 2, effective May 13, 2019. Judge Lopp shall remain as Judge *Pro Tempore* until Judge Jacobs informs the Court that he can resume the duties of the office or this Court issues a further Order.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Lopp to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Clark Circuit Court 2. Judge Lopp shall be entitled to compensation for his service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to T.R. 63(D).
