

Order Appointing Judge *Pro Tempore*

This Court has received from the Honorable Douglas M. Fahl, Judge of the Whitley Superior Court, his verified petition, with attached exhibit, for the appointment of a Judge *Pro Tempore* pursuant to Indiana Trial Rule 63(B)(1), due to his being called to active military service. And this Court being duly advised, finds that Judge Fahl's petition should be granted and that continuing the orderly administration of justice necessitates appointment of a Judge *Pro Tempore* to discharge the duties of Judge Fahl's office temporarily. This Court has been further advised that J. Brad Voelz, an attorney in good standing licensed to practice in Indiana, is willing to serve as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Whitley Superior Court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that J. Brad Voelz is appointed as Judge *Pro Tempore* in the Whitley Superior Court, effective July 6, 2016. This appointment shall remain in effect until further order of this Court. This order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Voelz to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Whitley Superior Court. Judge Voelz shall be entitled to compensation for this service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to T.R. 63(D).
