Minutes

2. **Minutes:** The minutes from the August 17, 2018 meeting were approved.
3. **Updates:**
 - a. **Cameras in the Courtroom:** After asking for additional information, the Supreme Court has not yet approved the draft order.
 - b. **Minimum Security Guidelines:** The Minimum Standards and amendment to AR 19 were approved by the Board of Directors at the September meeting with some amendment; the Board changed permissive standards to mandatory standards. The Supreme Court has not taken any action on these since Board approval.
 - c. **1st Amendment Auditors:** The draft memo on First Amendment Auditors has been useful within Committee members' courthouses, but it has not been published for wide distribution.
4. **Firearms Familiarization:** The next training with the Indiana State Police will be held on Saturday, July 13th at Pendleton. Amanda will ask the Judges Association to send out the email asking for sign up. The Committee requested another advanced training, similar to the one held in Shelby County.
5. **Other business:** Judge Cappas asked if there were resources for home security for judicial officers. This may be something to focus on in the future.
