



APPEARANCE RATE

- THE PERCENTAGE OF DEFENDANTS WHO APPEAR FOR ALL SCHEDULED PRETRIAL COURT HEARINGS
- FAILURE TO APPEAR ONLY COUNTS WHEN A WARRANT IS ISSUED BY THE COURT IN RESPONSE TO THE FAILURE TO APPEAR
- “ALL OR NOTHING”

SUCCESS RATE

- THE NUMBER OF SUPERVISED DEFENDANTS WHO (1) ARE NOT REVOKED FOR TECHNICAL VIOLATIONS OF THE CONDITIONS OF THEIR RELEASE, (2) APPEAR FOR ALL SCHEDULED COURT HEARINGS, AND (3) ARE NOT CHARGED WITH A NEW OFFENSE DURING PRETRIAL SUPERVISION

COMPLETION RATE

PRETRIAL DETAINEE AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY

- THE AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY IN JAIL FOR PRETRIAL DETAINEES WHO ARE ELIGIBLE BY STATUTE FOR PRETRIAL RELEASE
- LACKING JAIL DATA FOR COMPLETE PICTURE



INDIANA RISK ASSESSMENT SYSTEM – PRETRIAL ASSESSMENT TOOL (IRAS-PAT)




IRAS-PAT RESULTS



ODYSSEY TEXT REMINDERS

- HEARING DATA PULLED FROM ODYSSEY
- DEFENDANTS' CELL PHONE NUMBERS PULLED FROM THE SUPERVISED RELEASE SYSTEM (SRS) OR ODYSSEY
- TEXT REMINDER IS SENT 5 DAYS AND 1 DAY PRIOR TO SCHEDULED HEARING
- ADDITIONAL TEXT MESSAGE WILL BE SENT FOR CANCELLED OR RESCHEDULED HEARINGS WITHIN THAT 5 DAY RANGE
- EMAIL REMINDERS COMING SOON!

ODYSSEY TEXT REMINDERS

- WHILE IN THE CASE IN ODYSSEY, PRESSING ALT+F1 WILL LAUNCH THE "ODYSSEY REPORTING" INCITE APPLICATION TO DISPLAY A HISTORY OF TEXT REMINDERS FOR THAT CASE

(USERS DO NEED ACCESS TO ODYSSEY REPORTING VIA INCITE USER AGREEMENT)

Odyssey Text Messaging Reminder System

Overview

Odyssey courts can send text messages to remind defendants in criminal cases about upcoming hearings. The initiative is aimed at reducing the number of people who fail to appear in court—which can result in an arrest warrant being issued. Evidence shows reminders can be effective in reducing costly failure to appear rates. The reminders are also part of best practices designed to ensure community safety and fairness to defendants.

How It Works

The texts are sent automatically in any criminal case if there is a cell phone number for the defendant stored electronically by the court, the court is an Odyssey court, and the county has opted into the text system. There is no charge to the county to participate.

Reminders are sent 5 days and 1 day in advance of a hearing from either of the following phone numbers: 317-316-0810 or 317-286-6725. If a text message has been sent but the hearing is cancelled or rescheduled, another message is sent. Recipients can opt out by texting STOP in reply.

 - **OIWA – ORDER ISSUING WARRANT FOR ARREST**






TEXT REMINDER APPEARANCE RATE







APPEARANCE RATE BY COURT

HELPFUL TIP

- SOME DATA SETS WILL ONLY INCLUDE CLIENTS FORMALLY PLACED ON PRETRIAL SUPERVISION
- A FEW COUNTIES HAVE IMPLEMENTED A WAY TO TRACK CLIENTS WHO HAVE BEEN RELEASED FROM JAIL, BUT NOT ORDERED TO PRETRIAL SUPERVISION BY USING A GENERIC (TRACKING) OFFICER
- SRS AGENCIES CAN CONTACT THE TCT HELP DESK FOR ASSISTANCE IN SETTING UP THIS ADDITIONAL FEATURE

SRS PRETRIAL DATA REPORT

- STANDARD REPORT OPTION PROVIDED TO ALL PRETRIAL AGENCIES USING THE SUPERVISED RELEASE SYSTEM (SRS)
- REPORT CONTAINS A DATA TAB WITH ALL OF THE APPROVED PRETRIAL DATA ELEMENTS
- ALSO INCLUDES A REPORTS TAB TO ALLOW USERS TO QUICKLY VIEW AND ANALYZE DATA WITH PRE-MADE CHARTS AND GRAPHS
- USERS CAN ALSO MAKE THEIR OWN CHARTS/GRAPHS USING THE 85 DATA POINTS AVAILABLE ON THE DATA TAB






APPEARANCE RATE BY RISK LEVEL




APPEARANCE RATE BY IRAS-PAT TOTAL SCORE




APPEARANCE RATE BY IRAS-PAT QUESTION 4 (NUMBER OF FTA WARRANTS IN PAST 24 MONTHS)




APPEARANCE RATE BY RELEASE TYPE



APPEARANCE RATE BY SEX




APPEARANCE RATE TREND ANALYSIS






SAFETY RATE BY RISK LEVEL




SAFETY RATE BY RELEASE TYPE



SAFETY RATE BY SEX






SUCCESS RATE

- THE NUMBER OF SUPERVISED DEFENDANTS WHO (1) ARE NOT REVOKED FOR TECHNICAL VIOLATIONS OF THE CONDITIONS OF THEIR RELEASE, (2) APPEAR FOR ALL SCHEDULED COURT APPEARANCES, AND (3) ARE NOT CHARGED WITH A NEW OFFENSE DURING PRETRIAL SUPERVISION

SUCCESS RATE




SUCCESS RATE BY RISK LEVEL




COMPLETION RATE

- THE PERCENTAGE OF DEFENDANTS WHO REMAIN UNDER PRETRIAL RELEASE SUPERVISION UNTIL DISPOSITION
- COMPLETION COULD INCLUDE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SUPERVISION STATUSES:
 - COMPLETED
 - COMPLETED WITH TECHNICAL VIOLATION
 - COMPLETED WITH NEW OFFENSE/FELONY
 - COMPLETED WITH NEW OFFENSE/MISDEMEANOR
 - COMPLETED WITH AT LEAST ONE FTA

COMPLETION RATE




NON-COMPLETION ANALYSIS



CASELOAD RATIO

- THE NUMBER OF SUPERVISED DEFENDANTS DIVIDED BY THE NUMBER OF CASE MANAGERS IN THE AGENCY
- IF THE AGENCY IS TRACKING ALL SCREENED OFFENDERS, INCLUDING THOSE RELEASED WITH NO CONDITIONS, THE 'TRACKING OFFICER' CAN BE INCLUDED OR EXCLUDED FROM THE DATA ANALYSIS


CASELOAD RATIO


AVERAGE LENGTH OF SUPERVISION BY OFFENSE LEVEL


AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY




TEXT REMINDER APPEARANCE RATE
