

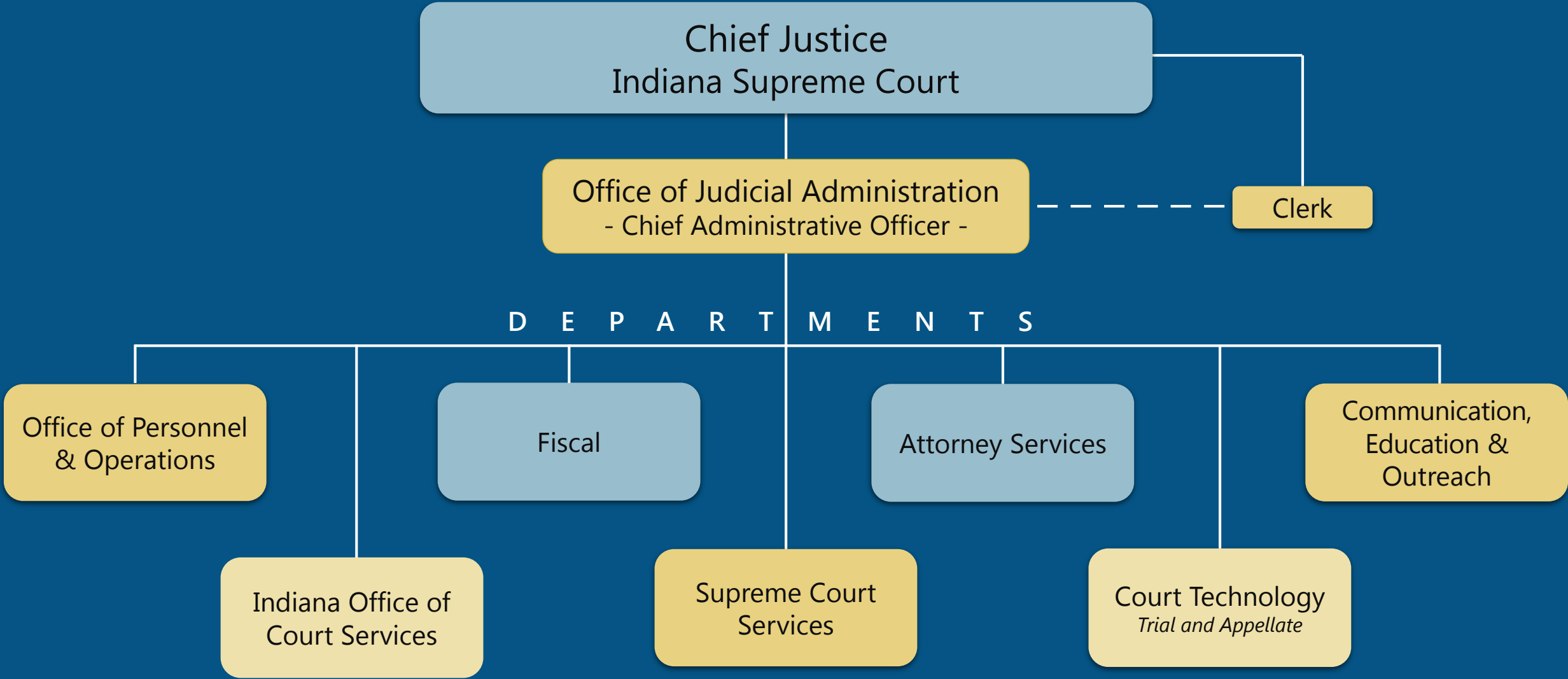

# Moving Away from Paper

## Indiana's Electronic Filing Initiative

### Statewide Implementation

- **July 2015:** Hamilton County is the first to begin e-filing
- **March 2017:** 34 counties are e-filing
- **Throughout 2017:** 26 additional counties
- **Statewide implementation complete by end of 2018**

**Nearly 48,000 E-FILINGS WEEKLY**  
14,000 Registered Users

as of March 2017

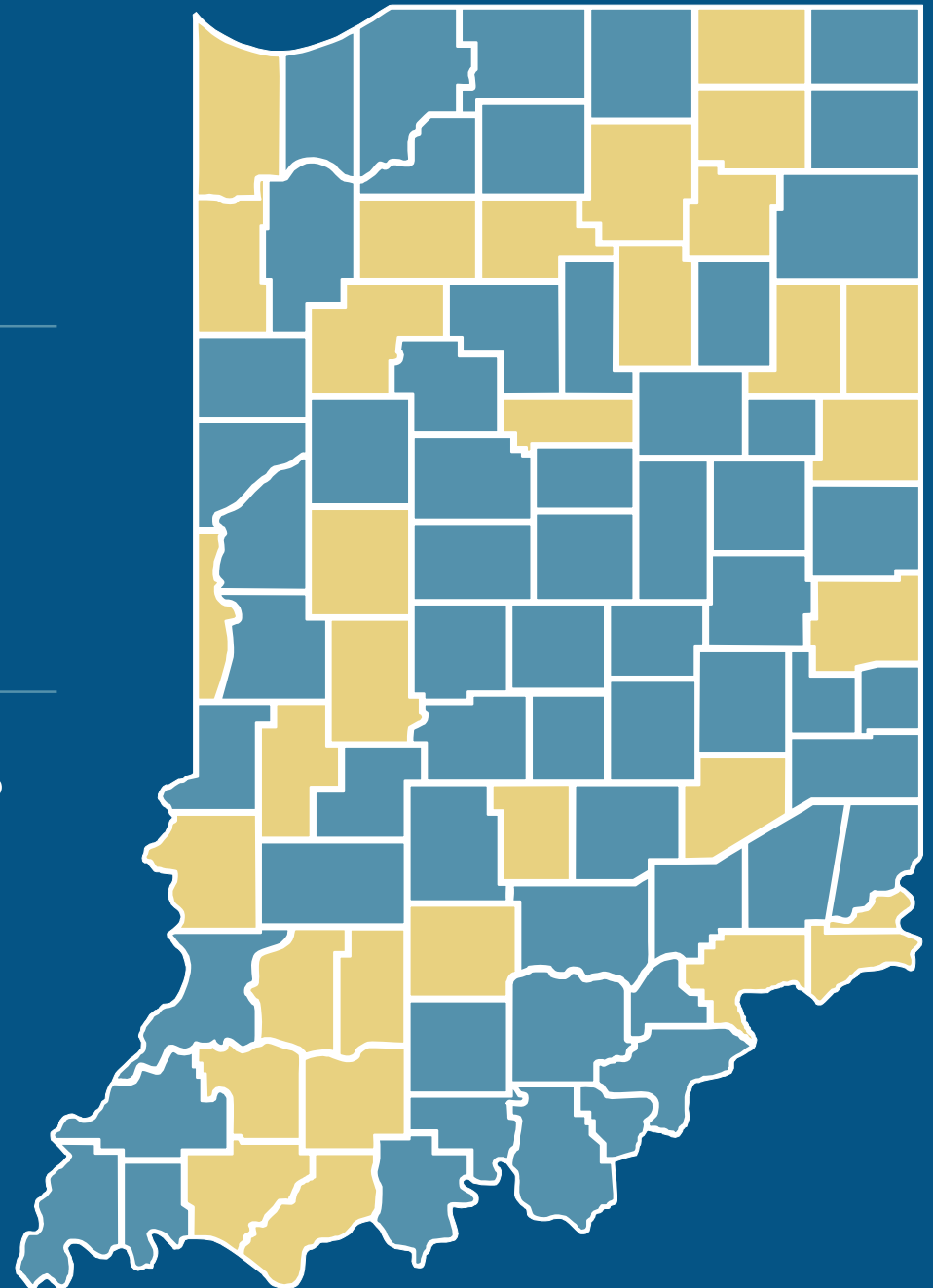

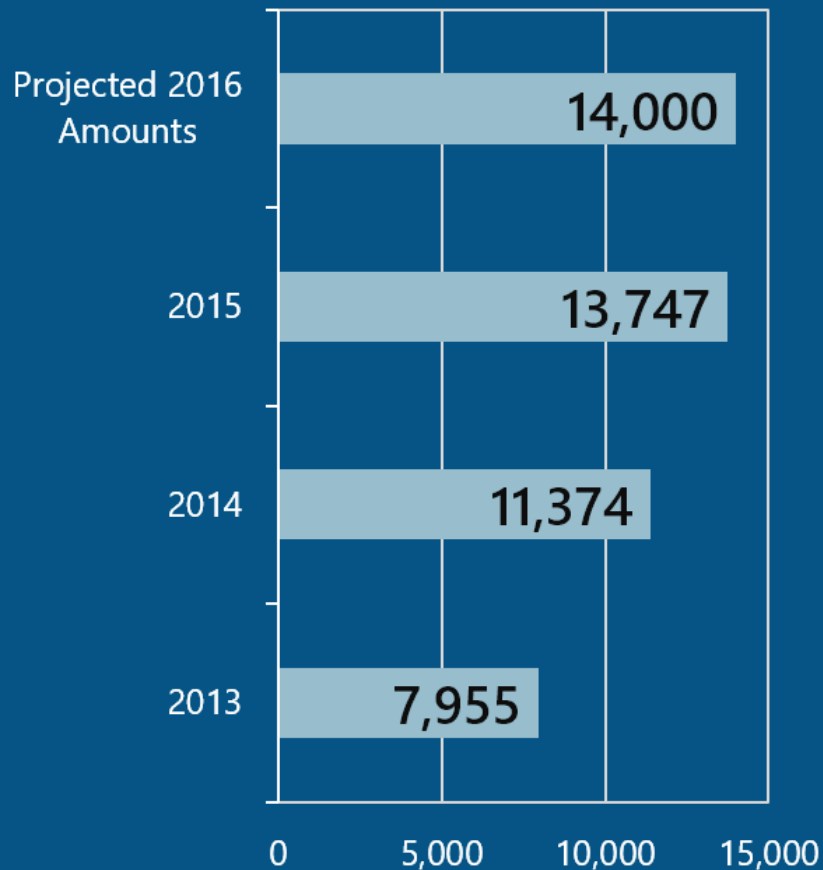

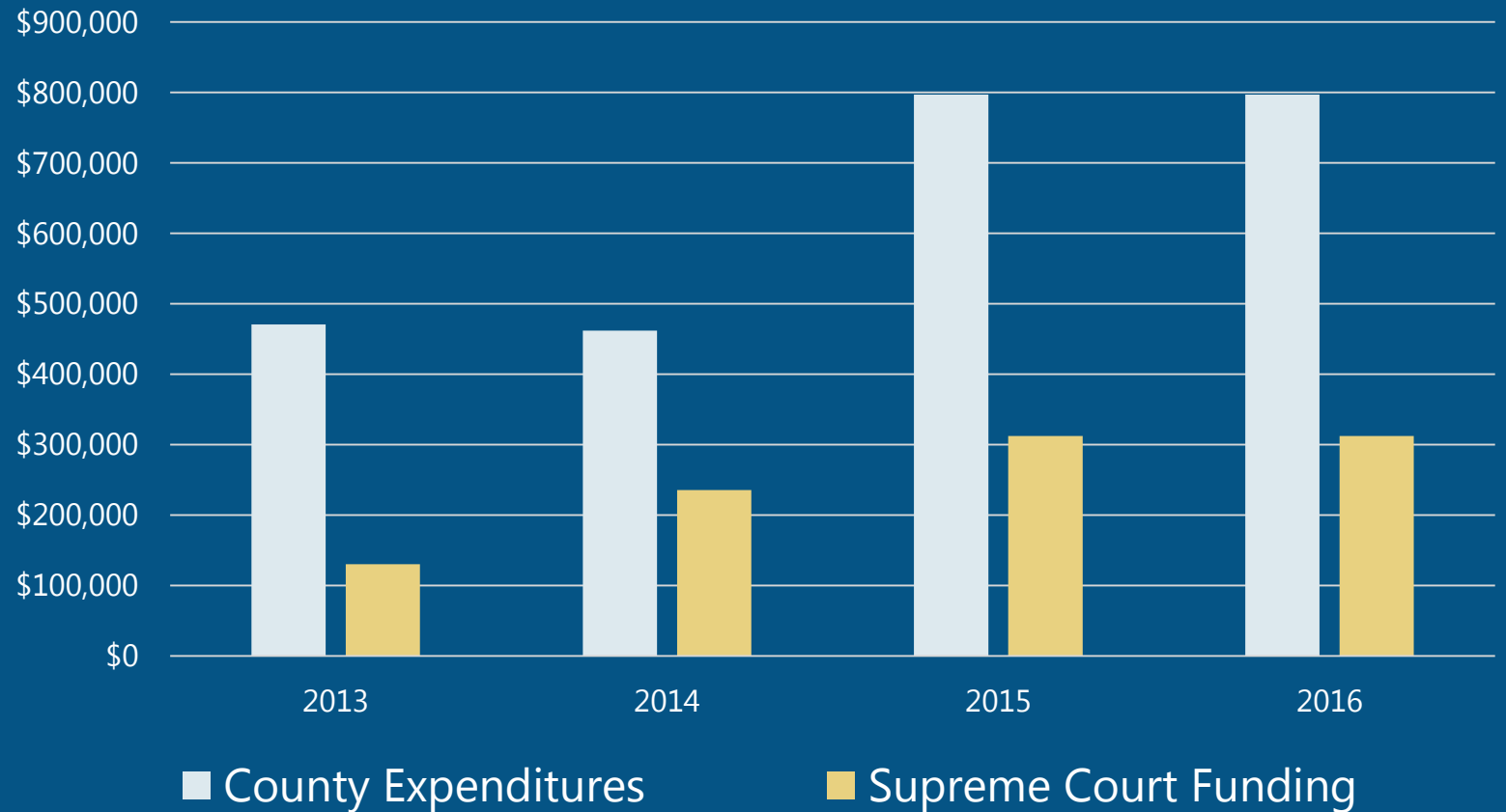
# Interpreter Needs & Costs

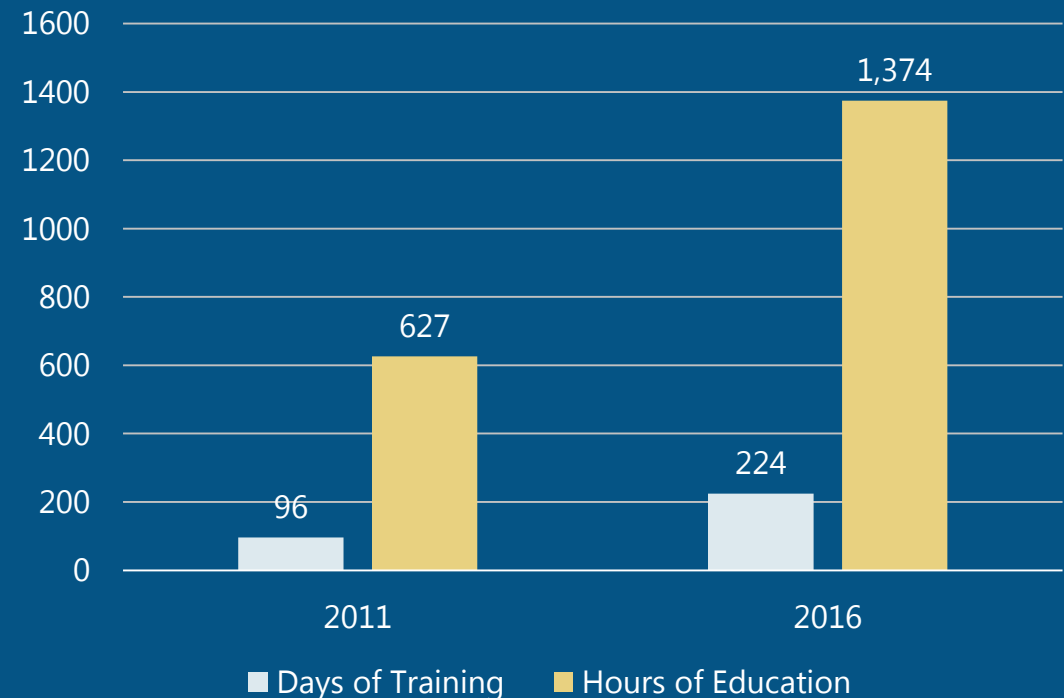
