
EBDM Sustainability & Scaling Up Project

Planning & implementation phases


EBDM Sustainability & Scaling Up:

Two Efforts Currently Underway

- **#1: Initiative Review Survey**

- Survey of all previous EBDM participants across 26 participating state and local teams
 - Purpose: Inform future work by identifying most/least helpful aspects of the project and technical assistance
 - Timing: within the next week or two

Two Efforts Currently Underway

- **#2: Monograph (Case Study) on Sustainability and Scaling Up**
 - Proposed focus on Indiana due to the many noteworthy aspects of your work (state team; engagement with local teams; sustainability plan; pretrial certification process; intention to expand to new counties, etc.)
 - Purpose: Demonstrate the potentials associated with multidisciplinary and multijurisdictional collaboration and alignment
 - Timing: final product due to NIC June 2021
 - Possibility: national webinar

What's Required?

- Indiana would be asked to identify a small project team (early March):
 - Assemble and share pertinent documents (late March)
 - Identify persons to participate in individual, remotely conducted interviews @ ~1 hour per interview (April)
 - Vet written materials (May)
 - All persons participating in the interview process would be invited to review drafts as well
