2012 Technology Sub-Grants

The Indiana State Library received 38 Technology applications requesting \$316,726 in LSTA funds. \$150,000 was awarded to 23 libraries.

2012 Digitization Sub-Grants

The Indiana State Library received 13 applications for digitization projects requesting \$214,875 in LSTA funds.

Eleven libraries were selected for funding, receiving over \$154,000.
