- I. Call Meeting to Order – by Trista at 1:00 PM

- IV. State Library Report
 - a. **Indiana Digital Library update.**
 - i. Jen: IDL now has a governing board, which had its first meeting April 21. They will establish committees to do Collection Development and Professional Development for staff. Next meeting 5/19. Will share stats in chat – pretty consistent with previous report.
 - b. **Evergreen update.**
 - i. Leigh Anne – Courtney is out doing a migration so not available
 - ii. Jeremy – We have two concurrent migrations right now: Crawfordsville and Jasper County. One is using Mobius – a new vendor for us – while the other is being handled by us. Also down a person until June 1 due to a maternity leave.
 - iii. Launch date for Crawfordsville is May 19
 - iv. Jasper County's launch date is August 11. Many more in the list – 11 currently. Recently approved requests from Middlebury and Goodland-Grant Township

- v. Josh – Can you tell us more about using starting to use Mobius as a vendor?
- vi. Jeremy – They are a well known Evergreen vendor – they host and support many consortia. They work with established Evergreen developers. Equinox is very busy right now and haven't been able to help with migrations as much, so we're using Mobius instead for many upcoming migrations
- vii. Jake – We have a glut of libraries in the pipeline – some because of losing Autographics, but also because Evergreen is great. Public libraries also have budget concerns right now and Evergreen helps with that. Many want to join, and the several year wait is not great and not feasible. We have a grant from Herbert Simon Foundation to expand support via Mobius. Evergreen is nearing 150 libraries, so out of 236 totally publics in the state that's almost a plurality that are in Evergreen. It speaks to the great work of the Evergreen team.
- viii. Stephanie – Yes, we'll be at 147 once the newest ones launch
- ix. Elizabeth – Are we still working with Equinox for support?
- x. Jeremy – yes, for current support

c. IN-SHARE update.

- i. **Leigh Anne:** April stats are similar to March – just a tiny bit fewer. Staying steady in the 2000-2500 range. Dip is possibly due to lots of current migrations – libraries not using Share after they're in Evergreen. Spring break also causes a dip, and we'll see lower rates in summer as well.

d. InfoExpress update.

- i. Leigh Anne. March 2026 was more parcels than March 2025, so the stats are doing very well. 65,000 for April is quite a lot! The couriers are very busy; we've had a few glitches with Louisville and Evansville hubs but most others are doing well. We met with NOW Courier staff in April to discuss issues we've noticed.
- ii. Trista: Evansville is doing tremendously better than before
- iii. Leigh Anne: Good! We're tracking on par for last year through April

e. **INSPIRE update:**

- i. Leigh Anne: The reason for inconsistent stats is difficult to tell. Perhaps with the database change over in early 2026 not everyone knew right away; at least there are a fair amount of searches. I've created a new chart for Rosetta stone in 2026 – we're glad it's back and users are up this year
