## This Week in Indiana History: July 10—July 16, 1863

On this week in Indiana History, General John Hunt Morgan led a group of Confederate soldiers into southern Indiana, making it the largest raid into Indiana during the Civil War.

### Defense of Indiana.

If any fears were entertained as to the disposition of the people of Indiana to defend their homes and to chastise any enemy who dared invade our State, those fears may be dispersed.

Indiana is this morning one grand military encampment, with more than 50,000 brave men under arms and prepared for a campaign.

### The Invasion of Indiana. Particulars of Morgan's Advent.

Latest rumors of the movements of Morgan were somewhat conflicting. Some reports have it that he is moving on Corydon, others that he has armaments on the Alice Dean and McCombs, which were floating down the river and were at Concordia on Wednesday night.

This would indicate a movement in this direction. The border is all ablaze, and every man able to bear arms and thousands of boys are under arms and eager to find the freebooter.
