The Indiana State Library has recently renovated a space on the second floor of the library, and created a Browsing Collection. The collection contains some of the newest and most popular items from the closed stacks, for patrons and state employees to browse and check out.

The space is a great place to relax during the lunch hour or any free time. Patrons can catch up on James Patterson's books in our large print collection or read about the history of Indiana breweries, the Colts, and more local topics from items in our Indiana collection. History buffs can find several new books of interest in our General Collection.

The Browsing Collection large print fiction is organized in alphabetical order by the author's last name, the rest of the collection is arranged by the call number, subject-based sections.

There are many categories of books to choose from including: American History; American States and Local History; Geography, Business, Finance, and Commerce; Economics and Management; Law and Education; Literature and Science; Sociology, The Family, Social Issues; Politics and Government; Medicine; Philosophy and Religion; Sports and Recreation; Technology Economics and Management

## **Gale Introduces New Mobile InfoTrac Interface**

On June 19th, Gale released a new, intuitive mobile interface in direct response to customer feedback. No setup is required by libraries to enable this automatic mobile display on smartphone's. The mobile interface has been user-tested to support the most common user workflows on Apple, Chrome, and Android smartphone's.

Users accessing any of the 57 InfoTrac resources on their smartphone will automatically be directed to the mobile version of the appropriate resource. In the mobile implementation, users will find a cleanly designed search screen. After performing a search, users will be able to explore their results using infinite scroll (as is preferred on mobile devices, they will not need to click through multiple pages of results). Individual documents have been formatted specifically for small screens, so users will not need to strain their eyes or resize the screen to view content of interest, and email functionality will allow users to easily send themselves bookmarked document links for future viewing.

## **Invitation to Participate in Broadband Speed Test**

You are invited to participate in a brief broadband speed test as part of the larger Digital Inclusion Survey ([digitalinclusion.umd.edu](http://digitalinclusion.umd.edu)). The FCC is gathering data to inform changes in the E-rate program and better understand library and school broadband needs. Speed test data from your library(ies) will help determine upload/download speeds that users experience at different times during the day - providing a critical measure of service quality in public libraries and helping to inform the FCC about library broadband needs.
