In this example, a search of

retirement planning was done in Academic OneFile. Search term results are shown in red (as they always have been), and InterLink results are shown in blue. The results will only show the first time a corresponding, appropriate result is found among the library s GVRL holdings, allowing library users to easily distinguish and review the results.

Clicking on an InterLink displays the list of relevant results from GVRL. Selecting an article opens it in a new tab/window in the Gale Virtual Reference Library environment.

Unlike traditional web search engines, clicking on a link doesn take your research in a completely new direction. Instead, InterLink allows you to continue your search to both expanding and narrowing your options
