CSLP seeking future theme and slogan suggestions



The Collaborative Summer Library Program is currently in the process of selecting a slogan for 2026 to go with the "Dinosaur" theme. CSLP is also in the process of selecting a general theme for 2027.

CSLP state representatives will solicit feedback and suggestions for slogans and themes via survey. The representative will then narrow down the suggestions to the most popular ones and submit those to the CSLP Theme and Slogan Committee. The committee then goes through the suggestions from all the state reps. They submit the popular suggestions to lawyers to be vetted in order to make sure they aren't copyrighted and that there are no other unforeseen issues. They also submit them to Spanish speakers who make suggestions for what will and won't translate well. The committee then holds a listening session where public library staff from across the country have an opportunity to weigh in on the final 20 or so suggestions. Finally, the CSLP state reps vote on the final slogan and theme at their Annual Meeting in the fall.
