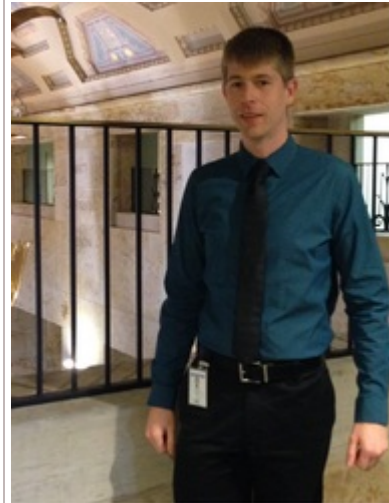

**ISL Building Celebrates 80 Years**



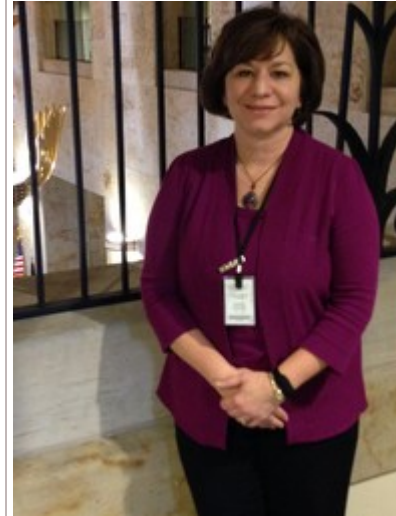
On December 7, 2014, the [Indiana State Library](#) building will celebrate 80 years at its current location, 315 West Ohio Street in Indianapolis.

The original Indiana State Library was established in 1825 to provide library services to Indiana's governmental officials and employees.

Since then our mission has changed to provide a wide range of collections for all residents of Indiana.

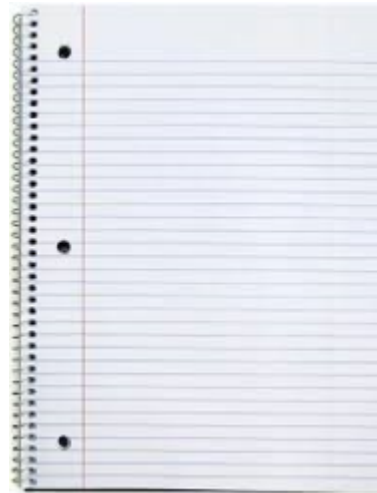
