Indiana House Enrolled ACT No. 1149 Chapter 5.3 Section 7

According to HEA 1149 Section 7, every Homebased Vendor (HBV) must obtain a food handler certificate (basic) from a certificate issuer that is accredited by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) (see below). Upon request, the food establishment/vendor shall provide a copy of the certificate to the local health department, state department or an end consumer.
