## SOURCE LIST FOR CHEMICAL TEST STRIP KITS:

The following is a list of suppliers of chemical test strips which are used to check the concentration of sanitizer in the final rinse water of the three compartment sink. Make sure that you purchase the type of test strip kit that coordinates with the type of sanitizer that you use:

<u>Chlorine test strips</u> – for sanitizers such as bleach, Steri-clor, Stera-Sheen, Beer Klean, etc that have chlorine as their base ingredient This level must be 50 – 100 ppm.

Ammonia chloride / QAC / Quat test strips – for ammonia chloride based sanitizers such as J-80, Quat, Xtra, and Sani-tabs This level must be 200 ppm.

<u>lodine test strips</u> – for iodine based sanitizers such as lodet.

This level must be 12.5 ppm.

H.E.L.P. test strips – for use only with DeVere brand H.E.L.P. sanitizer. This level should be 150 ppm (in the red color).
