


Who needs shots?

Immunizations are available at no cost for children from birth to 18 years.

Children ages 4-5 need immunizations for entry into kindergarten:

- DTAP #5
- Polio #4
- MMR #2
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) #2

Adults need immunizations too!
Call for fees.


TDap is required for 11-18 year olds

Meningococcal (meningitis) vaccine is required for 11-18 year olds

Hepatitis A – Two doses are recommended for 11-18 year olds

Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine is available for males and females ages 11-18. Call for details.

* Anyone receiving Varicella vaccine needs two doses



| Childhood Immunization Schedule | |
|---------------------------------|---|
| Birth | Hepatitis B #1 (HBV) |
| 2 months | DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, HBV #2, Rotavirus |
| 4 months | DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, Rotavirus |
| 6 months | DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, HBV #3, Rotavirus |
| 12 months | MMR #1, Varicella #1, Hepatitis A #1 |
| 15-18 months | DTaP, Hib, PCV |
| 18 months | Hepatitis A #2 |
| 4-6 years | DTaP, IPV, MMR #2, Varicella #2 |
| 11-18 years | Tdap, Menactra, HPV, Varicella #2*, Hepatitis A |
| Every 7 years | Tetanus booster |
