SUBJECT: Residential and Commercial On-site Sewage Systems and
Recessional Moraines in Northeastern Indiana

The recessional moraines in northeastern Indiana extend into southern Noble County. Because of their presence in Noble County, the recessional moraine procedures outlined in my memoranda must be applied to Noble County.

However, a review of soils and recessional moraine information for Noble County indicates that the procedure does not need to be applied county-wide.

Therefore, the procedure must be applied, when applicable, to only the following areas in Noble County:

- ◆ Sections 28 to 32 Township 33N, Range 11E
- ◆ Sections 25, 26, 35, and 36 of Township 33N, Range 10E
