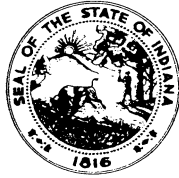

SUBJECT: Residential and Commercial On-site Sewage Systems and
Recessional Moraines in Northeastern Indiana

The recessional moraines in northeastern Indiana extend into southeast Steuben County. Because of their presence in Steuben County, the recessional moraine procedures outlined in my memoranda must be applied to Steuben County.

We have continued review of the soils and recessional moraine information for Steuben County based on the letter of September 18, 2001, from Tom Friend, Steuben County Health Department.

Therefore, the procedure must be applied, when applicable, to only the following areas in Steuben County:

- ◆ Sections 16 thru 18, 20, 21 28 thru 30, 32, and 33 of Township 36N, Range 15E
- ◆ Sections 13, 24 and 25 of Township 36N, Range 14E
