**SOP for Methamphetamine Labs:**

1. Upon notification of a methamphetamine laboratory, from an Indiana State Police methamphetamine laboratory occurrence report or other credible source, a letter of abatement shall be sent to the property owner.
2. The physical property shall be placarded stating the dwelling has been condemned by the Miami County Health Department and is unfit for human habitation.
3. If the property is listed for sale, the realtor or person selling the property shall be notified of the incident and procedures.
4. An attachment will be placed on the title of the property stating that a methamphetamine lab was located on the property. This attachment will be recorded at the Miami County Recorder's office with no charge to the Miami County Health Department.
5. After receiving a report from an IDEM licensed inspector stating the property is clean an attachment will be placed on the title stating the property has been cleared of the methamphetamine hazard.
6. The Miami County Health Department will then issue a letter of no further action to the property owner.
