



Memorandum of Understanding between the Recycling & Waste Reduction District of Porter County and Porter County Health Department

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been entered into by and between Recycling & Waste Reduction District of Porter County (RWRD) and the Porter County Health Department. It is intended to memorialize and document certain mutual understandings and agreements reached, intended to facilitate joint collaboration in advancing the jointly held mission of promoting and protecting the health and wellbeing of the citizens of Porter County. To that end, the Porter County Health Department and RWRD have agreed as follows:

1. The Porter County Health Department agrees to provide, at no charge, two (2) older automated external defibrillators (AED) to RWRD. The AED locations will also be placed on our PulsePoint AED registry.
2. RWRD agrees to place one AED at the Valparaiso Compost Site (2150 W Lincolnway) and one at the Boone Grove Compost Site (546 S. 400 W.).
3. Porter County Health Department agrees to provide hands only CPR and AED training to staff at no charge.
4. RWRD is responsible for testing the units monthly and for purchasing new batteries and pads as they expire.
