

# Porter County Recycling




Our leading cause of Trauma and Injury Related Death in Porter County is Substance Use Disorder. The initial step in our county-wide harm reduction initiative involves safe medication disposal at our office, along with sharps disposal, made possible by Porter County Recycling who has contracted with Stericycle. Our disposal services are promoted through our Porter County HUB Coalition and other community partners.



## What to do with used sharps?

**Put used sharps in a strong, plastic container**

When the container is 3/4 full, put the lid on, seal it with duct tape, and label DO NOT RECYCLE.
