Lack of transportation was widely noted as a barrier to care during our Public Health Needs Assessment. In response to this need we have contracted with Lyft to schedule rides for residents as needed, as well as developed a comprehensive bicycle program.

Porter County Health Department Free Bicycle Program

Goal: To provide a bicycle, helmet and lock at no cost to those that have no means of transportation to and from the grocery store, work, afterschool activities, healthcare appointments and anywhere else needed.

Qualifications:

- Be a Porter County resident
- Be at least 15 years old (those under 18 will need a guardian present when picking up the bike & equipment)
- Have a household income at or below 150% FPL
- Not already own a bicycle

A Lyft business account created to schedule and coordinate transportation for patients who struggle with transportation to get to medical appointments. Our Care Coordinator will schedule the rides and follow up with patients to ensure they are getting needed care.
