

The Porter County Health Department organized a heart screening clinic in November. The clinic saw 78 individuals between the ages of 10-20. Local echo technicians provided life-saving heart scans to identify any heart-related health issues, including arrhythmia, myocarditis and abnormal electrical activities.

This event was a partnership between the Porter County Health Department, Community Healthcare Systems, Valparaiso University, Kouts School and the Zac Mago Foundation. As a not-for-profit organization, the Zac Mago Foundation is dedicated to raising awareness and providing education on sudden cardiac arrest prevention. Porter County Health Department, Community Healthcare Systems and Zac Mago Foundation are planning another heart screening clinic on May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at Discovery Charter School.
