Public Notice of Petroleum Release

Local health departments are required by statute (IC 13-23-16) to inform the public of the discovery of released regulated substances at an underground storage tank site or in the surrounding area under 329 IAC 9-4-1(1) or a spill or overfill under 329 IAC 9-4-4(a). The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) was notified on January 17, 2024, of such an incident from the owner or operator of Marathon Unit 1955 located at 1506 Portage Avenue in South Bend. According to the release report from March 2019, groundwater and soil samples indicated the presence of Naphthalene, Trimethylbenzene, and TCE exceeding the allowable Commercial limits.
