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COVID-19 Cases Update

St. Joseph County- Ten (10) new additional individuals in St. Joseph County have tested positive for SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19 infection, bringing the county's total number of confirmed cases to 66. To date 20 individuals have recovered.

- **Stay home if ill.**
- **Adhere to the current Stay-at-Home order.**
