Public Notice of Petroleum Release

Local health departments are required by statute (IC 13-23-16) to inform the public of the discovery of released regulated substances at an underground storage tank site or in the surrounding area under 329 IAC 9-4-1(1) or a spill or overfill under 329 IAC 9-4-4(a). The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) was notified on July 21, 2022, of such an incident from the owner or operator of Former 1327 Clark Service Station located at 10038 McKinley Highway in Osceola. According to the initial release report, soil and groundwater samples were found to contain detectable levels of constituents of concern during the removal of a used oil underground storage tank.
