The following statement provides guidance for the public comment portion of the meeting, as well as the expected decorum for all conversations during the meeting.

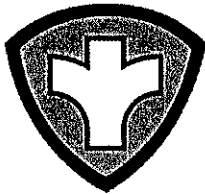

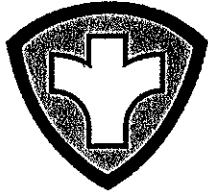
