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## COVID-19 Cases Update

St. Joseph County- As of today, St. Joseph County is reporting 2,017 active cases (red as it relates to County metrics), and our average is 167.7 cases per day (red) in the last seven days. Test positivity rate is 6.8% (as of 10/29/2020) (yellow). The R0 is 1.22 (as of 10/30/2020) (yellow).

Community transmission is extremely high. Ten percent (10%) of all cases of COVID-19 have been diagnosed in the past 7 days. We are strongly urging St. Joseph County residents to protect themselves and their loved ones by practicing mitigation strategies such as mask wearing, attention to physical distancing, hand hygiene and keeping gatherings outside of the family unit exceptionally small, (10 people or less) if at all.

The St. Joseph County Department of Health urges the continuation of the following actions:

- **Practice extreme physical distancing.**
  - Maintain at least 6ft between individuals.
  - Wearing a mask does NOT eliminate the need for physical distancing.
- **Practice frequent and proper hand hygiene & cough etiquette.**
  - Wash hands often, for at least 20 seconds, with soap & water; coughing and sneezing into your sleeve.
- **Stay home if ill.**
- **Limit indoor social gatherings to less than ten people.**

- **Abide by the current Public Health Order, requiring face coverings when going into an enclosed public space or business and when 6 feet of physical distance cannot be maintained within the enclosed public space or business.**
