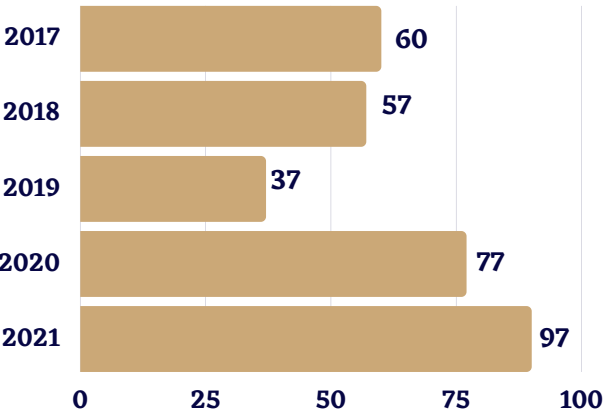


Health, Outreach, Promotion and Education (HOPE)

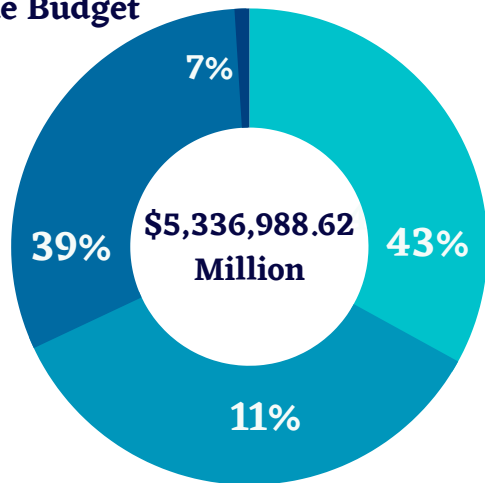

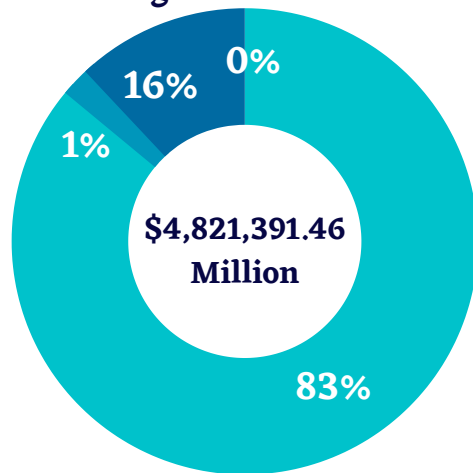

Environmental Health

- Conducted 68 lead risk assessments
- Conducted 1,059 septic inspections / consultations
- Conducted 114 Wellhead Protection Area inspections
- Conducted 38 routine massage establishment inspections and 28 tattoo/body piercing establishments
- 706 complaint responses regarding housing:
 - Pests
 - Cleanliness
 - Water shutoff
 - Waste disposal
- Processed 5,884 Property Transfers

Emergency Preparedness

- Ordered over 3,000 rapid COVID-19 Tests for the community
- Stocked over 8,000 PPE items such as gloves, masks, Band-Aids, hand sanitizer etc
- Facilitated monthly Emergency Support meetings
