- The facility is subject to inspection by the Department of Health during any time it is at a mobile site.
- All locations where tattoos are applied must be appropriately zoned.
- All practitioners must be licensed by the St. Joseph County Department of Health or the County or state in which they reside.
- A mobile permit shall apply for no more than 3 days and then be subject to renewal.
- Proof that each practitioner has been determined to be free of the designated communicable diseases within the last year must be available on site.
- If the mobile facility is not owned by a current licensed tattoo facility in St. Joseph County, additional information may be required.
- All requirements in St. Joseph County Code 114 related to the prevention of disease must be followed.
