COVID-19 Cases Update

St. Joseph County- Today we are confirming a third St. Joseph County resident has died due to COVID-19 infection. The patient, a woman in her sixties, had multiple underlying medical conditions and died following several days in an area hospital.

The St. Joseph County Department of Health urges the continuation of the following actions:

- **Practice extreme physical distancing.**
 - Maintain at least 6ft between individuals.
- **Practice frequent and proper hand hygiene & cough etiquette.**
 - Wash hands often, for at least 20 seconds, with soap & water; coughing and sneezing into your sleeve.
- **Stay home if ill.**
- **Adhere to the current Stay-at-Home order which has been extended to April 20, 2020.**
