St. Joseph County Department of Health COVID Vaccine Clinic Shifts Locations

St. Joseph County- Beginning Tuesday, July 6, 2021 the St. Joseph County Department of Health's COVID-19 vaccine clinic will be re-located to the main lobby of the County-City Building (227 W. Jefferson Blvd., South Bend). The COVID-19 vaccine clinic at St. Hedwig Memorial Center will close, Wednesday, June 30, 2021. Individuals receiving a first dose at St. Hedwig Memorial Center will receive their second dose at the new location.

Hours for the COVID-19 vaccine clinic in the main lobby will be as follows:

- Monday-Thursday, 8:30-6:00 p.m.
- Friday, 8:30-3:00 p.m.

Walk-ins will be accepted and welcomed. Individuals may still schedule a time at www.ourshot.in.gov or call the library at (574) 282-4646 for assistance.

Individuals entering the County-City Building who are not fully vaccinated, are required to wear a facial covering properly covering the nose and mouth as they are required at vaccination sites per the State of Indiana.
