The St. Joseph County Department of Health will host a series of community listening sessions to gather community input on the State of Indiana's public health infrastructure funding, *Health First Indiana*. *Health First Indiana*, formerly referred to as Senate Bill 4 or the Governor's Public Health Commission, passed into law on July 1, 2023, is a state-wide investment in local departments of health to support core services and to ensure all Hoosiers have access to foundational public health services.
