

How to Determine if You Qualify for a Free Radon Remediation System:

1. Pick up a free test kit on the 9th Floor of the County City Building or at any St. Joseph County or Mishawaka Penn Public Library Branch.
2. Complete the test and mail it to the lab in the pre-paid and labeled box.
3. If your results come back elevated, you will receive a letter from the Department of Health with instructions to contact a professional radon mitigator (a list of local contractors will be included or you can search our website), obtain a bid for a system, and send the bid along with a signed and dated Hold Harmless Agreement verifying your home ownership and income level (must be at or below \$100,000.00 per year for total household income).
4. The Department of Health will review and approve the bid, notify you to schedule the installation, and then will use grant funding for up to \$1500.00 for the system.
5. Once the work is complete, submit the invoice and updated results of the radon level (the contractor will provide those to you) for payment. Any cost that exceeds \$1500.00 must be paid for by the homeowner.

NOTE: If you have previously obtained elevated results from another test that wasn't obtained from the Department of Health, you may still qualify for a free system if you go through the above listed steps.
