Free Naloxone Training

In an effort to reduce opioid overdose fatalities in our community, the St. Joseph County Department of Health is pleased to offer Naloxone training at no cost to local businesses and organizations.

Opioid emergencies can happen anytime, anywhere, and to anyone.

Opioid overdose is the leading cause of accidental death in the United States. Most opioid emergencies happen at home, in front of a loved one.

This one-hour training includes:

- Understanding the burden of the opioid epidemic in St. Joseph County
- · Recognizing the signs and symptoms of an opioid overdose
- Discussion of stigma surrounding substance use disorders
- Explanation of how to use Naloxone (opioid overdose reversal medication)
- Description of Indiana legislation related to naloxone administration
- Identifying treatment and recovery options in St. Joseph County

Training participants will receive a dose of Narcan and certificate of completion upon request.
