Long term & Transitional Housing.

Number of Beds: 20 (10 Men's & 10 Women's) **Currently operating at half capacity due to Covid**

Number of Residents per room: 2 **only 1 per room during Covid.**

Assistance in accessing clothing: Yes

Meal Services: Dinner is provided every evening at 5:30pm on weekdays and 5pm on weekends.

Breakfast and Lunch is up to residents to fix for themselves from the houses' stocked pantries.

Assistance in Accessing a Case Manager:

Qualifications for Entry: In order to be considered for entry an individual must be 18 years or older or accompanied by a guardian. No married couples.

To initiate the admission process one must first inquire at Our Lady of The Road's resource center on Wednesdays between 1pm & 5pm. From there an interview process with staff will determine if the individual may become a resident.

There are no associated costs for residents.

Employment requirements are made on a case by case basis and will be an element of the agreement made with the staff, if required, during the interview process for admission.

Chores requirements consist primarily of a dishwashing or cooking shift every week.

Attendance to nightly dinners are mandatory as is attendance to a weekly house meeting every Sunday.

All residents must remain sober and cannot be currently using any drugs. Absolutely no violence is permitted.

The typical stay is 1 year, but a resident's stay may be extended without any hard limits in order to accommodate individual circumstances.

Negative Covid Test Required for Entry

During Covid no outside volunteers or students are invited into the house, nor are dinners open to the public.

Number of Residents per room: Men's and women's dorms are barracks style.

Family dorms have one family per room.

Qualifications for Entry: Intake is first come first served happening between Monday through Thursday 9 am - 3 pm and Friday from 9 am - 12 pm.

No unaccompanied minors and no sex crime or arson convictions allowed.

The first 45 days at CFH are free. After that, CFH assesses an occupancy fee of \$15 a week for the next 6 months, and \$25 a week after that. Guests without income are not denied service and may enter into a Sweat Equity agreement instead.

Guests are required to be working actively toward increasing self-sufficiency, as outlined in their self-sufficiency plans. Guests are also expected to contribute to the general upkeep of the facility through chores requirements.

Attendance at weekly community meetings are required. **Temporarily suspended due to covid.**

Guests must pass a drug and alcohol screen immediately prior to intake. CFH is a sober

living facility. Substances, paraphernalia, and weapons of any kind are not allowed on the premises.

Guests are encouraged to complete their stay within 2 years, with the average stay lasting 4-6 months. There are no limits on the number of stays at CFH, provided an individual does not get barred for violent or seriously disruptive behavior.

A negative test is required for entry.

Masks are strongly encouraged and mandatory when in isolation protocol.

Emergency and Transitional Housing

Number of Beds: up to 124 total.

34 emergency men's beds.

16 beds in 4, 4 bedroom apartments for single women.

Up to 48 beds in 12, 2 bedroom apartments for women with children. (Can be made to accommodate a single mother with up to 3 kids.)

Up to 25 beds in 5, 2 bedroom apartments for married couples and single fathers with children. (Can be made to accommodate a married couple or single father with 3 kids) 1 in a single 1 bedroom apartment.

Number of Residents per room:

Emergency mens housing starts in a large 10 man bunk room, but a resident can transition into 4 man bunk rooms

For transitional housing this varies on the size of the family, but a single adult can expect their own room.

Assistance in accessing clothing: Yes **Note that clothing assistance is available to residents and non residents alike.**

Meal Services: Residents are provided 3 meals a day at no cost.

Breakfast: 6 am - 7:30 am

Lunch: 11:15 am - 11:45 pm

Dinner: 6:15 pm - 6:45 pm

Non residents may also receive lunch and dinner at separate times from the residents.

Qualifications for Entry: To begin the pre-application process for transitional housing call Hope Ministries between 8 am and 5 pm. All sources of income must be

verified in this process and prospective residents will be interviewed as well as receive a tour of the facilities.

Referrals from another agency are preferred. Clients coming from emergency rather than transitional housing receive preference. Men with custody of children are also preferred as this is the only site they are welcome in northern Indiana.

Residents must be 18 or up or accompanied by a guardian and have no violent crime, sex crime, or arson convictions.

Residence is free of charge.

All residents must complete an initial 6 month on-site program. This includes meetings as well as chapel attendance (if residents do not want to utilize the onsite chapel they may substitute this with another religious service of their choice).

Addiction treatment meetings are required if applicable, on site treatment is available. A clean drug test is NOT initially required to gain entry but residents must become sober after entry.

Residents are subject after entry to routine random drug tests which they must pass. Absolutely no drugs or violence permitted.

Employment is not required but is strongly encouraged for residents without disabilities after completing the initial 6 month program. Residents will be provided assistance in acquiring employment.

Residents without disabilities are expected to assist in the kitchen as a chore requirement.

Residents may stay for a maximum of 2 years.

Residents have access to childcare services on site.

A computer lab is available to residents and non residents alike. **Temporarily only for residents due to covid**

No pets.

A negative covid test is required for entry.

Masks must be worn in common areas.

Classes temporarily limited to 10 people.

Supportive housing for individuals undergoing chemical and gambling addiction treatment.

Outpatient addiction treatment services are also available.

Number of Beds: 80 beds total.

68 mens beds

12 womens beds at Jane's House.

Number of Residents per room: 5 beds in 3 of the men's rooms

2 beds per room in all other rooms.

Assistance in accessing clothing: Yes, through case managers.

Meal Services: Yes

Breakfast: 7 am - 10 am

Lunch: 11 am - 11:45 am

Dinner: 4 pm - 4:45 pm

Assistance in Accessing a Case Manager: Yes

Qualifications for Entry: To initiate entry call Monday through Friday between 8 am and 4 pm.

An interview with an intake specialist will help determine a client's viability for residency.

Priority is given to pregnant women, women with children that have a substance use disorder, IV drug users and United States Veterans.

Residency is NOT free, fees are subject to a negotiation upon a sliding fee scale based on income.

First wash with the laundry services is free, after that it is 75 cents per wash.

Residents are required to search for employment Monday through Friday, 8 am - 11 am and again from 12 pm - 4 pm. Once employed their treatment program will accommodate their shifts.

Each resident is assigned a chore, typically one they must complete daily.

Residents must attend meetings for their treatment program as well as being strongly encouraged to attend AA or NA meetings.

Residents must pass a clean drug test in order to gain entry.

Residents are then subject to random drug tests for the duration of their admittance. Absolutely no drugs, alcohol or violence. Residents who relapse may be subject to ejection from the program.

A negative covid test is required for entry.

Masks must be worn in common areas.

Transitional and Supportive housing for United States Veterans.

Number of Beds: 24 beds total.

Number of Residents per room: Residents stay in 3 man bunk rooms.

Assistance in accessing clothing: Yes

Meal Services: Yes

There is a kitchen residents may use to prepare their meals, or they may go next door to Center for The Homeless and eat in their cafeteria at meal times.

Assistance in Accessing a Case Manager: Yes

Qualifications for Entry: To initiate the entry process contact the VA (574-272-9000) Monday through Friday between 8 am - 4:30 pm. All residents must be referred through the VA. This includes an interview process at the VA.

Any male Veterans lacking housing who are NOT convicted of a sex crime or arson are eligible. Both honorable and dishonorable discharges are welcome. Does NOT accept National Guardsmen or Army Reservists.

There are NO costs for residents.

There is NOT an employment requirement, although case managers will assist Veterans in gaining employment if they are seeking it.

Chores are required if it does not impose an undue burden upon a resident.

Residents are able to participate in marches and parades.

Residents must attend group meetings every wednesday on varying topics as well as a house meeting every Thursday.

A drug test is required upon entry, but a positive drug test will not bar a resident from entry so long as they fail to show up positive on future drug tests.

Residents are subject to random drug testing for the duration of their stay.

Absolutely no drugs, alcohol or violence at the facility.

Residents may stay up to 2 years with the average stay being 6 months.

Call between 7 am - 6 pm to reach a case manager.

Negative covid test is required for entry.

Licensed residential care facility offering long term care.

Number of Beds: 144 beds total.

Typically more spaces available for men than women.

Number of Residents per room: 3-4 residents per room.

Single rooms available to accommodate resident's needs.

Assistance in accessing clothing: Yes

Meal Services: Yes.

Full kitchen with dietician assisting in crafting nutritious meals per client needs.

Breakfast: 7 am - 8 am

Lunch: 11:30 am - 12:30 pm

Dinner: 5 pm - 6 pm

Qualifications for Entry: To initiate the entry process contact the Social Services/Admission Coordinator to arrange a tour and interview online, or by calling Monday through Friday between 8 am - 4 pm.

Fill out required Prospect Inquiry paperwork (Social Services can help if needed with completing this form).

Arrange for medical and psychiatric evaluations to be sent to Portage Manor.

To obtain financial assistance you will need to bring verification of all income and assets (Social Security award letter, VA, alimony/child support, cash value of life insurance, bank accounts, stocks, bonds, securities, certificate of deposit, rental property, or other property; all assets).

When all medical records and financial arrangements have been approved an assessment will be done by a nurse. Then the Admission Team/Committee will decide

to approve admission; a date and time of admission will be scheduled.

A physical exam must be completed within 72 hours prior to admission. A TB skin test place or Chest X-Ray completed. A statement of "Free of Communicable Disease" from MD received. Orders from physician for all medications, treatments, diet, and follow up care must be included and signed by physician for admission to Portage Manor Licensed Residential Care Facility.

Residents must be above the age of 65, or if between the ages of 18-65 must be blind, or have mental or physical disabilities to be considered for entry.

Individuals who are not from St. Joseph County will only be considered if there are at least 4 open spaces. St. Joseph County residents will be given preference for entry.

The private pay rate is \$60 a day, but financial assistance is available. Almost all residents receive financial assistance.

NO employment or chores requirements.

Meetings are only required if part of medically prescribed treatment.

Residents must NOT present a threat to other residents or staff.

Residents may stay until their needs are no longer able to be met, or they move back into the community.

Residents who leave on involuntary discharge must wait 1 year before they can reapply for residency.

Residents who leave of their own volition may reapply whenever they need but must go through the application process again.

A negative covid test is required for entry.

Testing is available on site for staff and residents.

Residents must wear masks when in communal areas.

All staff must pass a temperature check to enter and wear a mask.

10 for men

5 for women

Number of Residents per room: 2-3 beds in each room.

Assistance in accessing clothing: Yes, through case managers.

Meal Services: Yes

Open kitchen for residents to make their own meals.

Monday through Thursday dinner is served for the residents at 6:30 pm - 7:30 pm

Assistance in Accessing a Case Manager: Yes

Qualifications for Entry: Residents must have been incarcerated in the last calendar year. NO women with children, minors, individuals convicted of sex crimes or arson. Not accessible to elderly or handicapped individuals.

All residents must complete a 90 day reentry program.

Resident's fees are \$460 a month.

Recovery works are accepted for eligible residents.

Residents must have or acquire first shift employment. Residents not already employed upon entry will be provided with assistance in obtaining employment. Residents without employment must volunteer in the community 4 hours a week.

Residents with employment must volunteer in the community 4 hours a month.

Temporarily suspended during covid.

Residents must also complete assigned chores throughout the week.

Attendance at dinner Monday through Thursday is mandatory.

Attendance at weekly house meetings, meetings with case managers, and special programming in the evening is also required.

Curfew is at 8 pm for the first 30 days.

Curfew is at 10 pm AFTER 30 days.

2 weekend passes a month can be made available.

No violence, drugs or alcohol permitted.

Residents are subject to random drug tests for the duration of their stay.

Residents must remain cordial with one another.

No romantic relationships between residents, staff or volunteers.

Residents must stay at least 90 days to complete their reentry program.

Typical stay is 6 months.

Maximum stay is 2 years.

A negative test is required for entry.

Employment is required, but exceptions can

Residents must acquire a 12 steps fellowship
sponsor upon entrance.

There is no maximum time a resident may stay, but after a year goal orientation takes priority.

A negative test is required for entry.

Masks must be worn in communal spaces.

Residents must pass a temperature check to get in during covid.
