Tipton County Launches Prenatal Food Box Program to Support Expectant Mothers and Families

Tipton, IN – The Tipton County Health Department is pleased to announce that Tipton County has been selected to participate in a regional pilot of the Indiana Department of Health's (IDOH) Prenatal Food Box Program, launched in collaboration with Gleaners Food Bank and participating local health departments.

This initiative provides nutritious food and health-related resources to pregnant individuals to promote healthy pregnancies and positive birth outcomes. Eligible participants will be screened and enrolled through the Tipton County Health Department. The program includes:

- One dry food box and one produce box every two weeks
- Prenatal vitamins and recipe cards
- Information about local resources such as WIC and home visiting programs

Additional Health Services Available

During food box distributions, the Tipton County Health Department will also offer:

- **Routine Adult and Pediatric Vaccination Clinics**
Vaccinations will be available for individuals ages 3 and older and may be administered at the time of food box pickup.
- **Lead Testing for Children**
Point-of-care lead testing is available for children 9 months and older. Results are provided on-site within 5–10 minutes and will be shared with families and the health department.

Distributions will take place on the **second and fourth Wednesday of every month.**

FAST FACTS

- You can join the program at any time during your pregnancy
- One dry food box and one produce box are provided at each distribution
- Extra services such as vaccinations and lead testing will be available onsite
- Insurance is not required to participate (if you do have insurance, please bring your information to registration)
- Distributions occur every two weeks
- Pre-registration is required before your first event
