DETERMINATION OF QUORUM

OLD BUSINESS:

Syringe Exchange Program

Dr. Coulter spoke on the latest issues of the exchange program and the legal issues involved. The documents will be sent to the state for approval. The location of the site will be a Centerstone facility.

Zika Virus

Mark Linderman reported six cases of the Zika virus have been reported in Indiana, all cases from travelers. Environmental inspectors are contacting businesses about standing water being removed to avoid mosquito infestation.

NEW BUSINESS:

Union County Health Clinic request

Union County Health Department contacted Dr. Coulter concerning Wayne County taking over the responsibility for the Health Center. The federal government will be releasing funds for 2017.

Dr. Rider made a motion to pursue application for 2017 and Jeff Butler seconded the motion, the motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Coulter spoke of the housing issues the inspectors handle. Meth houses have to be condemned, per special state requirements. In addition there are numerous housing cases that the housing director, Dan Burk, addresses each week.

Angela McDaniel spoke on lead levels in homes from paint. Water issues with lead have not been a problem in this area.

Dr. Coulter spoke of past issues with human resources; Chris Beeson suggests talking to Rodger Smith at budget time, to renew the proposal to increase the salaries of the Environmental Health Specialists.

Dr. Rider made a motion to adjourn; Jeff Butler seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
