Welcome and Introductions

Bill Beranek called the August 1, 2022 meeting of the Marion County Public Health Department Local Emergency Planning Committee to order at 3:35PM. All committee members were greeted, and roll call was taken. Jeff Larmore reported a quorum was present.

Approval of the June 6, 2022 Minutes

Andrew Bowes made a motion to approve the June 6, 2022 minutes, Marshall Shackelford seconded the motion. The June meeting minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's Report

Jeff Larmore shared the treasurers report and reviewed the expenditures so far this year. The unexpected cost to the LEPC cost center has been removed. Since the June meeting, the LEPC has entered a contractual agreement with Resilient Strategies for the 2022 full-scale exercise. The LEPC purchased SO2 gaskets for "C Kits" for an IFD and CSX training. \$212.59 was used for water, disinfectants, and other miscellaneous expenses for a July District 5 training. For the LEPC notification phone line, \$377.13 has been spent.

Committee Reports

District 5 Hazardous Materials Training & Advisory Council –Ron Troutt/Jeff Larmore

Ron Troutt shared about the A, B and Dome clamp kits training at Station 44. In August there is a bonding and grounding training being held. In September, Ron Huffman will be sharing a propane course at Station 44. The last training of the year will be held at Ivy Tech in Lawrence. This course is going to cover ERDSS, which is an online computer program.

District 5 Hospital Emergency Preparedness Committee – TJ Edwards, Andrew Bowes, Anne Edwards, Chris Pogorski

TJ Edwards shared Eskenazi is going over an active shooter plan and they are joining the LEPC exercise in October. Andrew Bowes shared the hospital coalition meeting will be held on August 12th. The Indiana Hospital Emergency Preparedness symposium will be held on September 8th and 9th. Anne Edwards shared MESH is still observing Covid numbers. Chris Pogorski shared Medxcel is having internal tabletops regarding evacuations.

Hazardous Materials Exercise Coordination Committee- Jeff Larmore

Jeff Larmore shared the LEPC has signed a contract with Resilient Strategies for the 2022 Full-scale exercise with JCI Jones. The concepts and objectives meeting was held in July. Another exercise planning committee meeting is being held on August 3, 2022. The dates for the full-scale exercise and two days of drills are as follows; October 12th is the first day of drill, October 13th is the full-scale exercise, and October 14th is the last day of drill.

Old Business

Metal Working Lubricants

Janette Smith is continuing work with Metal Working Lubricants, along with the surrounding neighbors to help identify the source of odors.

Indiana Emergency Response Commission

Jeff Larmore shared during the last IERC he learned about an exercise the State of Indiana and US EPA are working on hosting in Columbus, IN for RMP facilities. The exercise is about a cold storage facility located in downtown Columbus. The exercise will be held at the Bartholomew County fairgrounds on August 24th.

New Business

Jeff Larmore shared Interstate Warehouses has asked the LEPC to meet with the executive committee. Jeff Larmore stated he has received numerous questions about RMP facilities here within Marion County. One question was how many are in Marion County, Jeff shared there are 24 facilities. The LEPC is hopeful to hear about HMEP grant funds in September.
