Bill Beranek called the August 7, 2023 meeting of the Marion County Public Health Department Local Emergency Planning Committee to order at 3:34PM. All committee members were greeted, and roll call was taken. Jeff Larmore reported a quorum was present.

Approval of the June 5, 2023 Minutes

Justin Mast made a motion to approve the June 5, 2023 minutes, Ron Troutt seconded the motion. The June meeting minutes were approved as written.

Treasurer's Report

Jeff Larmore shared the expenses so far for fiscal year 2023, totaling \$6509. Commitments so far are \$30,795. The LEPC has received an invoice for contractual services for the 2023 LEPC exercise. The one-ton chlorine trainings props arrived and are being held at IFD Station 44 training grounds. Jeff shared the LEPC will need to buy training books for the October technician class. The funds from the 2022 HMEP grant have all been used aside from \$227. The notice of funding from the state has not been sent out at this time. The treasurer's report was accepted with acclamation.

Committee Reports

District 5 Hazardous Materials Training & Advisory Council –Ron Troutt/Jeff Larmore

Ron Troutt discussed the training in June IFD hosted a propane flaring class at IFD Station 44. The training in July covered A, B, and C chlorine kits. In October, there is going to be a radiation course. This training will be held at Stout Field and taught by the IDHS Radiation program. In November, there will be an unknown substance/white powder response training.

District 5 Hospital Emergency Preparedness Committee – Justin Mast

Justin Mast shared the MGT course being hosted by Eskenazi is full. The D5HEPC has been hosting a Center for Domestic Preparedness course which covers decontamination processes. Two courses have been held, one at Eskenazi, the other at St. Francis. The committee is looking for dates for their third and fourth classes.

Jeff Larmore shared the exercise planning committee met last week for the midterm planning meeting. A save the date for the 2023 LEPC Table-top exercise will be sent out here soon. The tentative date for the table-top meeting will be October 11, 2023.


