## How to Shelter-In-Place

During a chemical emergency closing your house tightly will help keep the chemical out.

- 1. Go indoors immediately.
- 2. Close all windows, doors and fireplace dampers.
- 3. Shut off furnace, air conditioner, kitchen and bathroom fans, and clothes dryer.
- 4. Move to a room with few windows, BUT NOT THE BASEMENT.
- Close the door and place a damp towel under it.
- 6. Cover cracks near windows with tape or plastic.

- 7. Turn on a TV or radio and listen for further instructions.
- 8. When the all-clear is given, open your windows to air out your house and go outdoors.
