

How to Shelter-In-Place

During a chemical emergency closing your house tightly will help keep the chemical out.

1. Go indoors immediately.
2. Close all windows, doors and fireplace dampers.
3. Shut off furnace, air conditioner, kitchen and bathroom fans, and clothes dryer.
4. Move to a room with few windows, BUT NOT THE BASEMENT.
5. Close the door and place a damp towel under it.
6. Cover cracks near windows with tape or plastic.
7. Turn on a TV or radio and listen for further instructions.
8. When the all-clear is given, open your windows to air out your house and go outdoors.
