CMS releases new ICD-10 diagnosis codes; IHCP adds codes to Emergency Department Autopay List

In accordance with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), and in response to the national emergency that was declared concerning the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) is implementing a new diagnosis code, U07.1 – *2019-nCoV acute respiratory disease*, into the *International Classification of Diseases, Tenth Revision, Clinical Modification* (ICD-10-CM), effective April 1, 2020.

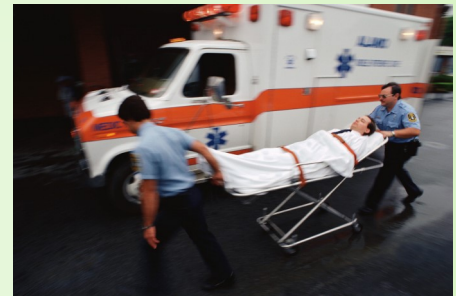
In accordance with the CMS, the CDC NCHS is also implementing another new diagnosis code, U07.0 – *Vaping-related disorder*, into the ICD-10-CM, effective April 1, 2020.

Effective for dates of service (DOS) on or after April 1, 2020, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) will update its policies to reflect the updates to ICD-10-CM.

The IHCP is adding U07.0 and U07.1 to the managed care health plans' *Emergency Department Autopay List*, accessible from the [Code Sets](#) page at in.gov/medicaid/providers. For information about the *Emergency Department Autopay List*, see *IHCP Bulletin BT202009*.

These diagnosis codes are also considered emergency diagnosis codes for fee-for-service (FFS) claims.
