IHCP updates Preferred Diabetes Supply List

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) announces it will update the Preferred Diabetes Supply List (PDSL), effective for dates of service (DOS) on or after Jan. 1, 2023.

The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) selected Abbott Diabetes Care, Dexcom, Roche Diabetes Care and Trividia Health as preferred vendors for glucose testing products for the IHCP.

The PDSL was created to identify the diabetes glucose testing products preferred for all IHCP programs, subject to limitations established for certain benefit packages (see *IHCP Bulletins* [BT201047](#) and [BT201055](#)). Updates to the PDSL are published periodically.

PDSL pharmacy claims

The point-of-sale (POS) pharmacy claim submission process for Abbott Diabetes Care, Roche Diabetes Care and Trividia Health PDSL products will remain unchanged. Managed care POS pharmacy claims for all Dexcom PDSL products must be submitted using the bank identification number (BIN), process control number (PCN) and/or RX Group of the pharmacy benefit manager (PBM) associated with the member’s enrollment.

Fee-for-service (FFS) POS pharmacy claims for all Dexcom PDSL products must be submitted to the FFS PBM, OptumRx, as shown in Table 2.
