## IHCP updates Preferred Diabetes Supplies List

The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) selected Dexcom, Roche Diabetes Care, and Trividia Health as preferred vendors for diabetes supplies for the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP), effective **Jan. 1, 2023** (see *IHCP Bulletin* [BT2022119](#)).

The Preferred Diabetes Supplies List (PDSL) was created to identify diabetes glucose monitoring products preferred for all IHCP programs, subject to limitations established for certain benefit packages. Updates to the PDSL are published periodically.

Effective Oct. 1, 2023, the IHCP is adding the Dexcom G7 Continuous Glucose Monitoring (CGM) System to the PDSL. Table 1 provides an updated list of all products on the PDSL, effective for dates of service (DOS) on or after Oct. 1, 2023.
