IHCP updates requirement for MSRP and cost invoice

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is updating the requirement for the manufacturer's suggested retail price (MSRP) and cost invoice for manually priced items. Effective Jan. 7, 2024, the maximum age for an MSRP or cost invoice is two years from the date of service. Providers will be required to submit the **most current** MSRP or cost invoice that is not older than two years with claims for manually priced items.

Effective for dates of service on or after Jan. 7, 2024, claims with MSRP or cost invoice documentation that is greater than two years old will deny with explanation of benefits (EOB) code 6169 – *The MSRP/ cost invoice submitted with the claim is not acceptable for adjudication. The provider can resubmit the claim with proper documentation.*
