## Nonemergency ALS and BLS ambulance transports for FFS members will not be brokered through Verida

Effective July 1, 2023, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is changing the nonemergency medical transportation (NEMT) policy to carve out all NEMT services for basic life support (BLS) and advanced life support (ALS) ambulance transportation services from the fee-for-service (FFS) Medicaid NEMT brokerage.

All BLS and ALS ambulance services for FFS members will be nonbrokered services. ALS and BLS transports should be scheduled directly with IHCP ambulance transportation providers and not arranged through the FFS NEMT broker, Verida. This change applies to all transports for dates of service (DOS) on or after July 1, 2023. Transports occurring for DOS prior to July 1, 2023, continue to remain the responsibility of the FFS NEMT broker, Verida. Existing policies regarding other types of transports are not impacted. For example, wheelchair van transports provided by ambulance providers for FFS Medicaid members will continue to be scheduled through Verida after this policy change (unless exempted from brokerage for some other reason, such as in the case of dually eligible members or, effective July 1, 2023, members residing in a nursing facility; see *IHCP Bulletin <u>BT202352</u>*).

Ambulance providers should bill the appropriate procedure codes for nonemergency ALS and BLS ambulance services based on the types of services provided according to medical necessity criteria during the transport; see Table 1. Claims for these transports must be submitted to Gainwell Technologies for adjudication.

Procedure code	Description
A0420 U1	Ambulance waiting time (ALS), one-half (1/2) hour increments
A0420 U2	Ambulance waiting time (BLS), one-half (1/2) hour increments
A0424	Extra ambulance attendant, ground (ALS or BLS) or air (fixed or rotary wing); (requires medical review)
A0425 U1	Ground mileage, per statute mile, ALS
A0425 U2	Ground mileage, per statute mile, BLS
A0426	Ambulance service, advanced life support, nonemergency transport, level 1 (ALS 1)
A0428	Ambulance service, basic life support, nonemergency transport, (BLS)

Table 1 – Procedure codes for nonemergency ALS and BLS ambulance services, excluded from brokerage
for FFS members effective for DOS on or after July 1, 2023
