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
IHCP issues CCBHC-specific encounter code updates and guidance

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is releasing guidance on how specific service encounter codes should be implemented under the Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) model. This guidance has been collaboratively developed by the Division of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHA) and the Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP).

This guidance provides information on how specific service encounter codes should be implemented and operationalized under the CCBHC model in Indiana, to ensure that providers meet service expectations and billing requirements.

Each code definition includes:

- Modality definitions
- Eligible populations to receive services
- Allowable and unallowable activities/services under the specified codes
- Eligible providers to render services
- Any additional code-specific requirements
