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Five incontinence, ostomy and urological supply codes no longer subject to contracted vendor requirements

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has reviewed the *Incontinence*, Ostomy and Urological Supplies Available Only Through Contracted Vendors (for Fee-for-Service Members) code table in comparison with the incontinence vendor contracts. As a result of this review, five codes will be removed from the code table, effective immediately retroactive for dates of service (DOS) on or after Jan. 1, 2024.



This change applies to fee-for-service (FFS) claims only.

Table 1 – Incontinence, ostomy and urological supply procedure codes no longer subject to contracted vendor requirements for FFS members, effective for DOS on or after Jan. 1, 2024

Procedure code	Code description
A4360	Disposable external urethral clamp or compression device, with pad and/ or pouch, each
A4436	Irrigation supply; sleeve, reusable, per month
A4437	Irrigation supply; sleeve, disposable, per month
A5056	Ostomy pouch, drainable, with extended wear barrier attached, with filter, (1 piece), each
A5057	Ostomy pouch, drainable, with extended wear barrier attached, with built in convexity, with filter, (1 piece), each
